

Proof of residence

Acceptable proof - a paper copy of one of the following items with the applicant's name and address:

- Council Tax bill
- Rental agreement
- Utility bill
- Driving licence
- NHS Medical card
- A prescription or formal letter from an organisation such as a hospital, school or Department of Work and Pensions (DWP)

Proof of Identity

Acceptable proof - a paper copy of one of the following items with the applicant's name and address:

- A copy of your birth/adoption or marriage certificate
- Your bus pass
- Your passport
- Your driving licence

Providing an acceptable photograph for your Blue Badge

The following guidance should help you to provide an acceptable photograph for your Blue Badge. Your photograph will be printed on your Blue Badge so that you can be identified as the Blue Badge holder.

We cannot issue a blue badge without a photo which meets these guidelines.

Please supply a recent colour photograph, which has the applicant's name printed on the back. It must be:

- Standard passport size 45mm high x 35mm wide (millimetres) The photograph can be taken at a self service booth or any suitable photograph cut down to size (35 mm x 45 mm).
- You must be facing forward, looking straight towards the camera
- You must not be wearing any head covering, unless it is worn for religious beliefs or medical reasons
- Nothing should be covering your face, please make sure the outline of your eyes, nose and mouth are all clearly visible
