Work Package Title:	Dealing with competing revenue demands in the sector
Overview:	This work package will determine how competing revenue demands will be addressed.
Context:	<p>In relation to existing competing revenue demands in the homelessness sector it is proposed that</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Current or proposed services should be considered against the proposed criteria for 'specialised' housing support services in the strategic commissioning approach at the same time as the future of all other existing contracts are considered. ▪ 'Unmet needs' such as domestic violence and Aids/HIV are met through widening access to existing floating support services and through changes to service specifications and/or increasing floating support capacity. ▪ The needs of BME groups such as gypsy and travellers and migrant workers are met through remodelling or re-commissioning of existing floating support services rather than commissioning small scale 'BME specific' services.
