<p>Wherever appropriate staff should assist people to find solutions to their own difficulties without the need for social care services.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Actively promoting benefit take up.</li> <li>◆ Promote alternative solutions such as:</li> <li>◆ Information from leaflets, websites, catalogues,</li> </ul>	<p>The person must:</p> <p>Have needs above the threshold for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Needs Relating to Your Physical and Mental Health <b>or</b></li> <li>◆ Needs Relating to Your Personal Care / Domestic Routines / Home Environment.</li> </ul> <p>AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Be unable to meet the need appropriately self</li> <li>◆ Have no other person willing or able to assist</li> <li>◆ For extra care or adult placement – they meet the specific service criteria</li> <li>◆ Meet the dependency criteria set out in the Residential and Nursing Home Care Bandings documents.</li> <li>◆ For nursing care, they must meet the criteria for Free Nursing Care.</li> <li>◆ Not be eligible for Continuing NHS health care</li> </ul>	<p>Direct Payments – see relevant section above.
