<p>Promote Benefit take-up.</p>	<p>The person must have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Needs Relating to Your Physical and Mental Health <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Needs relating to Your Personal Care/Domestic Routines/Home Environment <p>AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ The person is in agreement with the Intermediate Care/rehabilitation plan. <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ The person needs further assessment. ◆ Not be eligible for relevant support from Supporting People. ◆ Not be eligible for Continuing NHS health care <p>AND</p> <p>Meets the service criteria for the specific service</p>
