this leaflet suggests 3 easy-to-follow days out by bus and train using your Dartmoor Sunday Rover ticket. All the services are part of the Dartmoor Sunday Rover network of bus and train services.

## your day out costs so little



## buy your ticket...

from the driver on any Dartmoor Sunday Rover bus, at Plymouth rail station, or from the conductor on the Tamar Valley or Dartmoor Line trains.

## when you can use your ticket...

**every Sunday from 29th May – 18th September 2005**

Bank Holiday Monday 29th August – there is no Dartmoor line train on Bank Holidays and the ticket is not valid on Tamar Valley line trains.

## and there's more

The days out shown in this leaflet are just a few of the many trips that can be enjoyed using your Dartmoor Sunday Rover ticket. If you would like to plan your own day out, pick up a copy of the Sunday Rover guide – it contains complete timetables and further suggested days out.

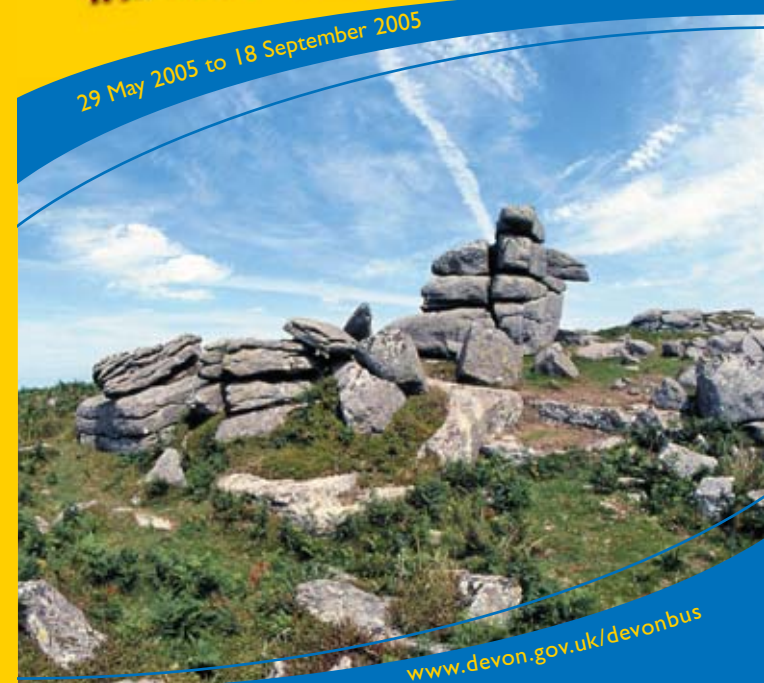

# The Grand Tour

Transmoor Link, City of Plymouth,  
Tamar Valley Line, Okehampton

Enjoy the wonderful views from the top deck of the famous Transmoor Link bus travelling across the heart of Dartmoor through Postbridge and Princetown to Plymouth. Time to explore the city before catching a train along the scenic Tamar Valley Line to Gunnislake. Then by double deck bus through Tavistock and along the northern edge of the moor to Okehampton Station which has been restored to traditional Southern Railway style. Return to Newton Abbot via Moretonhampstead.

You can also travel from Dawlish Warren depart 0901, Dawlish depart 0907, Teignmouth depart 0918 by bus 170 and change at Newton Abbot. On the return bus 85A departs Newton Abbot at 2000 to Teignmouth arriving 2028, Dawlish arriving 2037 and Dawlish Warren arriving 2043.

# Classic Circular

Totnes, Widecombe-in-the-Moor,  
Tamar Valley Line

Travel by bus past Dartmeet, Two Bridges and Princetown to Tavistock. Time to explore this unspoilt market town before continuing by bus through Lydford and along the northern edge of Dartmoor to Okehampton where the station has been restored to traditional Southern Railway style. Next through Drewsteignton and Moretonhampstead and passing Haytor Rocks to Widecombe-in-the-Moor. Time here to explore the village and enjoy a Cream Tea before returning to Newton Abbot via Bovey Tracey.

You can also travel from Dawlish Warren depart 0901, Dawlish depart 0907, Teignmouth depart 0918 by bus 170 and change at Newton Abbot. On the return bus 170 continues to Teignmouth arriving 1901, Dawlish arriving 1910 and Dawlish Warren arriving 1916.

# Moorland Explorer

Widecombe, Castle Drogo, Okehampton

First a scenic ride by bus through Bovey Tracey and past Haytor to Widecombe-in-the-Moor, where there is a chance to explore the village gift shops. Next through Moretonhampstead to Castle Drogo\* where you can take time to stop for lunch and explore the house and gardens. Continue your trip to Okehampton where you can stop for refreshments in the buffet or explore the gift shop before returning to Newton Abbot.

\*You can obtain discounted admission to Castle Drogo on production of your Dartmoor Sunday Rover ticket. Free admission to grounds.

You can also travel from Dawlish Warren depart 0901, Dawlish depart 0907, Teignmouth depart 0918 by bus 170 and change at Newton Abbot. On the return bus 85A departs Newton Abbot at 1815 to Teignmouth arriving 1846, Dawlish arriving 1858 and Dawlish Warren arriving 1904.

Don't forget you can now travel to Sherborne Road on any Stagecoach or First bus. Buy your ticket from the driver on the first bus you board.
