FREE ACCESS TO THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES DOCUMENTSONLINE WEBSITE EXTENDED TO MARCH 2012

We are now offering free downloads of documents from the National Archives DocumentsOnline website until March 2012, through our public access computers at the Devon Record Office.

Downloading of scanned documents from the DocumentsOnline website is FREE, instead of costing £3.50 per document. You will only have to pay for the cost of any printouts you make, at 10 p. per A4 sheet. Or you can save the downloaded copies to your own memory stick.

Included on DocumentsOnline are:

- **Campaign Medal Index Cards, First World War (WO 372)**
- **Selected volumes of soldiers' service records from the Royal Hospital Chelsea, mainly 1843-1899.**
- **Registers of Seamen's Services (1853-1923)**
- **Royal Marines Service records (1842 -1936)**
- **Prerogative Court of Canterbury wills (1384-1858)**
- **20,000 wills of seamen of the Royal Navy (1786-1882)**
- **Death Duty registers (1796-1811)**
- **Recommendations for Honours and Awards made to British army personnel and those of the dominions, 1935-1990 (WO 373)**
- **Aliens Registration cards (those living in the London area) from 1914**
- **Other documents – see them listed on the website itself**

In order to offer this service fairly to all visitors, the current booking arrangements for using our public access computers are continuing.

These computers are currently available from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. for hour-long sessions. Access to computer sessions are allocated by staff through the Devon Record Office reception desk.

We do not take advance bookings by telephone or email, but visitors to the record office are able to book a session on the day, and rarely have to wait long, if at all, to use a computer. Those visitors wishing to access other websites such as Ancestry, or to use the computers for other purposes, are also required to book a session.
