

Exeter St Davids Station to City Centre Walking Route

A series of way-marking signs have been created to guide you from St Davids to the city centre (Queen Street and Central Station). Simply follow the signs.

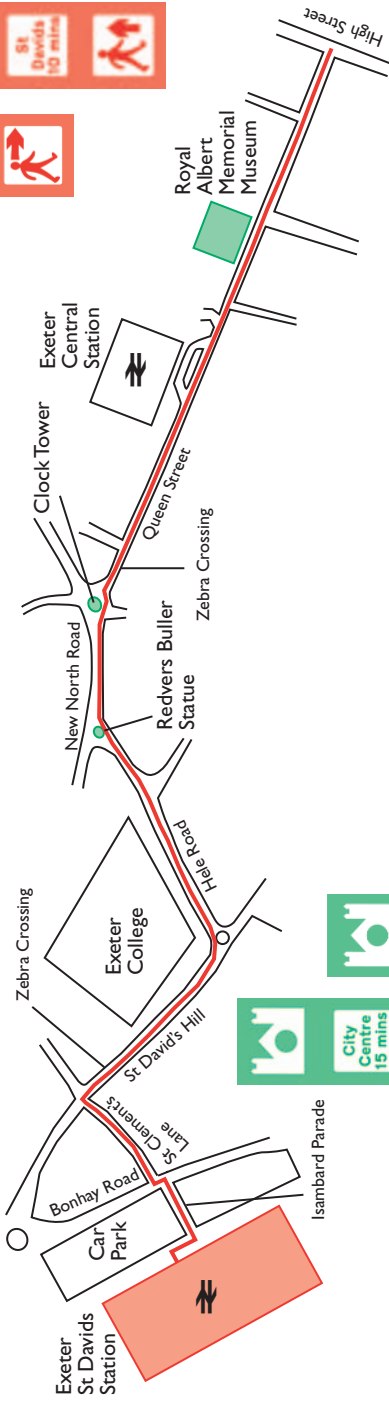
They will not only indicate the way, but also how long it will take in five minute intervals.

The whole route should take you only 20 minutes, plus, walking up the hill will use at least 100 Kcals (more if you walk fast or are carrying a bag!).

- From the station exit, turn right and cross in front of the taxi rank on the raised, paved crossing;
- go straight along in front of the shops on Isambard Parade;
- cross Bonhay Road at the puffin crossing and turn left;
- then immediately turn right into St Clement's Lane;
- walk up St Clement's Lane and turn right onto St David's Hill;
- cross St David's Hill at the zebra crossing and turn right;
- continue up St David's Hill and follow the pavement around to the left at the mini-roundabout in to Hele Road;
- continue past the Exeter College entrance, and cross Hele Road at the traffic lights next to the statue of General Sir Redvers Buller;
- turn left and follow the pavement along New North Road to the Clock Tower;
- cross the end of Queen's Terrace on the raised paved crossing in to Queen Street;
- walk along Queen Street, cross at the zebra crossing and turn right;
- continue along Queen Street to pass Central Station and the Royal Albert Memorial Museum to reach the High Street.
- The map overleaf and red signs will help you re-trace your steps back to the station.
