- 6** Cancellations at least one working day before intended travel will be accepted free of charge. If you cancel the booking on the day of travel you will still be expected to pay the fare.

● **What is the Fare Car?**

Fare Car provides a range of journey opportunities from the All Saints, Alston, Chardstock, Churchill, Dalwood, Furley, Hawkchurch, Holy City, Membury and Smallridge areas to and from designated points in Axminster and Chard. Like a bus service, Fare Car has fixed arrival and departure times and points. Unlike a bus, Fare Car only runs for passengers who have arranged a journey in advance.

Fare Car is operated by BW Taxis by formal agreement with Devon County Council. This is a public transport scheme financially supported by Devon County Council offering innovative public transport to rural areas.

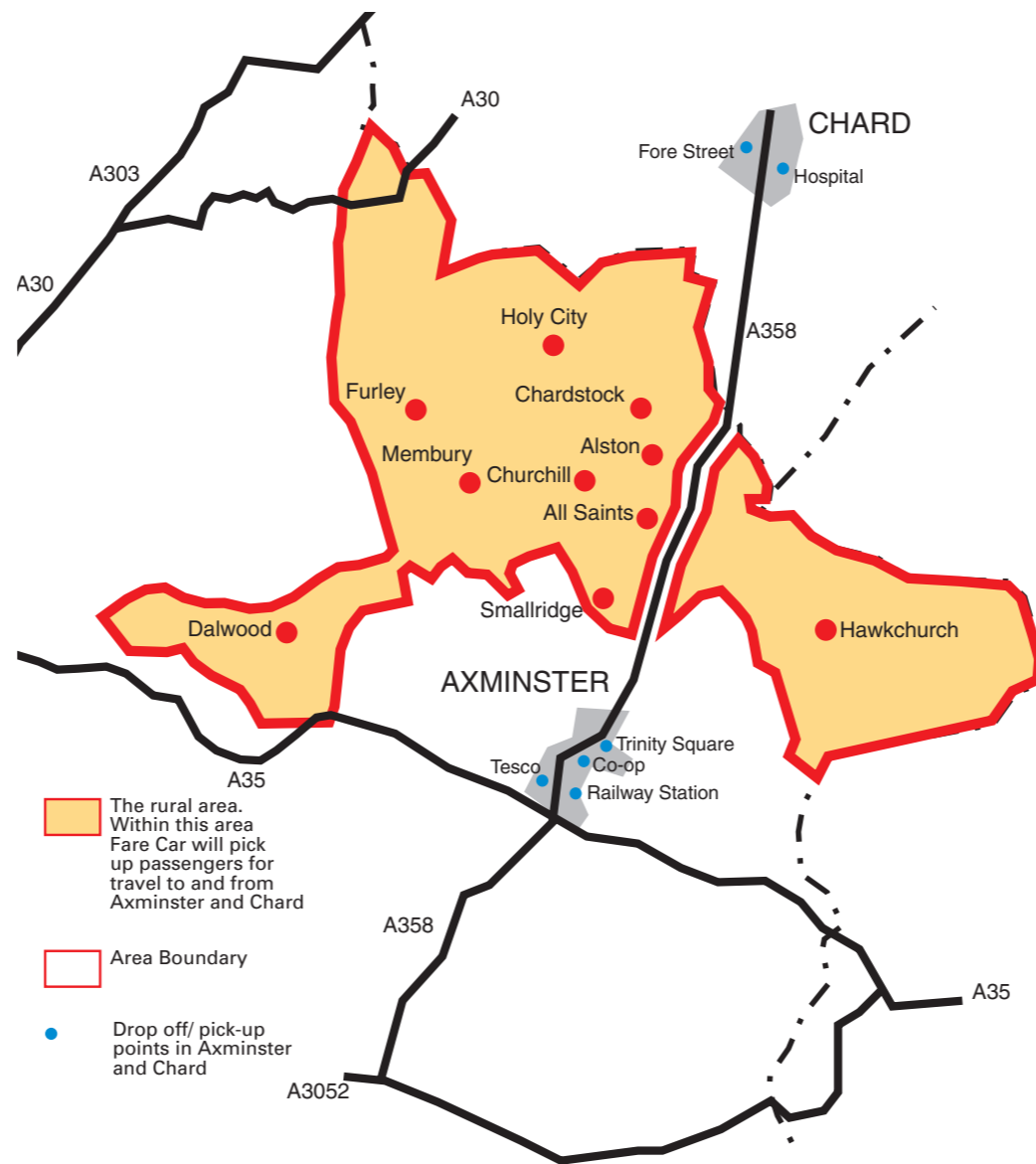
● **What's so great about Fare Car?**

- several journey opportunities, every day of the week (excluding public holidays)
- access to shops, doctors, hospital, leisure facilities and work (last Axminster only)
- opportunities to connect with other public transport services
- a taxi-style service at special fares
- helpful, friendly and fully licensed drivers that are CRB checked with modern comfortable vehicles (wheelchair access may be available)

● **Who can use the service?**

Anybody of any age may use the service to travel within the designated area at the times it runs. There is no longer a membership club. All you need to do is to arrange your journey in advance.

**Area covered**



● **Where can I go and what will I pay?**

- starting from any point in the designated rural area (see map) to and from designated points in Axminster and Chard.
- starting from any designated point in Axminster and Chard to and from any point in the rural area. (Fare Car will do its best to reach any address but some points may not be accessible by the vehicle, the cars are not obliged to leave the public highway.)
- Fare Car will not take passengers between Axminster and Chard.
- **£2.00 per single trip.** This is a subsidised fare. There are no further reductions for over 60's, children or other categories, except children under 5 who travel free.

● **When does Fare Car run?**

The revised Fare Car area comes into effect on 5th March 2007. The service provides several journey opportunities per day within the specified area.

● **What do I do next?**

When you wish to travel you will need to confirm your journey in advance by phoning the co-ordinator on 01460 53400 any time between 0900 and 1700 Monday - Friday and between 0900 and 1200 Saturday **at least one day before intended journey.**

- 1 Select the journey(s) you wish to travel on from the timetable.
- 2 Phone the co-ordinator to confirm your journey.
- 3 Tell the co-ordinator the day and date you wish to travel, where you would like to be picked up, and your destination. You will then be given an approximate pick-up time. Please also state the number of people wishing to travel including children and infants. Please give the co-ordinator a contact telephone number.
