● What is the Fare Car?

Fare Car provides one journey per day on Wednesdays from the rural area within the red outline on the map on the next page to and from Cullompton town centre. Like a bus service, Fare Car has a fixed arrival and departure time. Unlike a bus, Fare Car only runs for passengers who have arranged their journey in advance.

The service provides a door-to-door service in the rural area to all places on the public highway using Private Hire cars.

The service is operated by Sparky's Taxis under contract to Devon County Council, replacing Redwoods Travel bus service 695 which has been withdrawn.

Passengers have two and a half hours in Cullompton - time to access shops, doctors, dentists and chemists.

● Where can I go and what will I pay?

Starting from any point in the designated rural area (see map) to Cullompton War Memorial, returning from outside Cullompton Market House. Fare Car will do its best to reach any address but some points may not be accessible by the vehicle. The cars are not obliged to leave the public highway.

Fare of **£3.50** per single journey. This is a subsidised fare. There are no further reductions for pensioners including National Bus Pass holders, children or other categories, except children under 5 who travel free.

Anyone may use the service.

● How do I arrange a Fare Car journey?

You will need to arrange your journey in advance by calling TRIP Community Transport on 01404 46529 between 0900 and 1600 Monday to Friday. **Please ring them up to a day in advance.**

● How do I do this?

- 1** Select the Wednesday you wish to travel and whether you are making a single or return trip.
- 2** Phone TRIP on **01404 46529** to arrange your journey.
- 3** Tell them where you would like to be picked up.
- 4** Please mention any requirements for carriage of wheelchairs, pushchairs or child seats. Please also state the number of people wishing to travel including children and infants.

You will then be given an approximate pick-up time. Please be ready on time as this is a shared service but with a timetabled arrival time in the town and other passengers may need to be picked up en route. Please give TRIP Community Transport a contact number.

Cancellations before 1600 on the working day before travel will be accepted free of charge. If you cancel the booking on the day of travel you will still be expected to pay the fare.

If you have any queries or questions the TRIP co-ordinator will be happy to help.
