To do this we must ask you about your ethnic group.

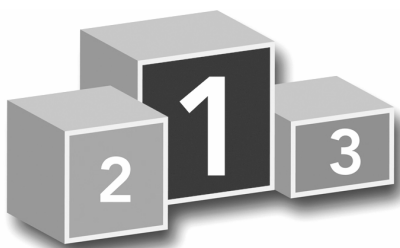


We will write down your ethnic group on your records.
