Falls are no laughing matter

Falls can lead to...

Injury, reduced quality of life, reduced mobility and loss of independence.

You are more at risk of a fall if you have...

- **fallen before**
- **take 4 or more medicines**
- **had a Stroke or have Parkinson's Disease**
- **a problem with your balance**
- **difficulty getting up from a dining chair without using your arms.**

Every 5 hours an older person dies as a result of a fall in the UK.

Every day 22 people in Devon call an ambulance due to a fall.

If you have a fall – don't panic

Call for help – try to shout, bang on the wall or crawl to the phone.

Assess the situation – decide if you can get up.

If you think you can get up...

- 1. Roll onto your hands and knees.**
- 2. Crawl to a stable piece of furniture such as a bed or chair.**
- 3. Place your hands on the bed or chair for support.**
- 4. Place one foot flat on the floor bending your knee in front of your tummy.**
- 5. Lean forward. Push onto your hands until you bring the other foot beside the first.**
- 6. Turn and sit on the bed or chair.**
- 7. Rest for a while before getting up.**

If you are hurt and think you can't get up...

- 1. Rest and wait.**
- 2. Move to a safe surface such as a carpeted area.**
- 3. Keep warm and move out of draughts.**
- 4. Keep moving – try to move your arms and legs and roll from side to side if you can.**
- 5. Continue to call for help.**

After any fall, report it to your GP and seek medical attention.
