## How much we pay for your community-based care

Factsheet 54 – 27 July 2011 (3 Pages)

**You may recently have been asked to make a decision between care in your own home (otherwise known as community-based care) and care in a residential or nursing home.**

**We have a responsibility to meet certain care needs for everyone in Devon who has those needs. We must do this using the resources that are available to us. Sometimes the amount of care someone would need to stay in their own home can be more expensive than the cost of residential care, such as a nursing home.**

**If you would prefer community-based care in your home, and we think that it will meet your needs, we will try to provide that care, taking into account the guidance in this fact sheet. This is based on national government guidance on managing the resources which are available to us.**

**If we are not paying for all the community-based care that you need**

**and you don't want to go into residential care you may accept the community-based care we pay for and arrange other ways to pay for the remaining care that you need, subject to mutual agreement on how all identified needs are to be met.**

**Normally, we will not pay more for community-based care than we would pay for residential care to meet your needs. For many people we make this calculation using current banded rates for care home placements. More information on this is available from your care manager.**

### **NHS contributions**

**We will not take Funded Nursing Care contributions or other NHS contributions into account when we compare the costs of community-based care and residential care.**

### **Services for carers**

**We will not include the cost of providing services to a carer when we compare the costs of community-based care and residential care. We usually consider 'services for carers' as:**

- Services which a carers' assessment has identified as necessary; and**
- Short-term breaks or day care.**

**If you do not agree with our decision**

**If you are unhappy with any decision we make regarding your care you have the right to complain using our complaints procedure.**
