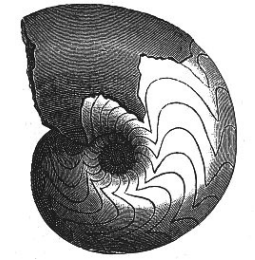


# Educational Register of Geological Sites
