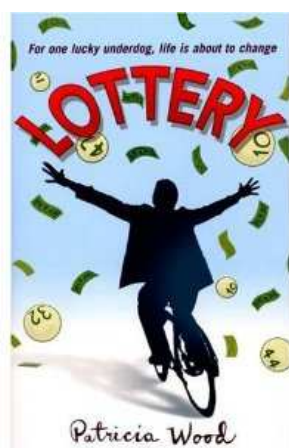


## **Lottery by Patricia Wood**
