Issues / Concerns

- Extend “Life in the Bus Lane” project to people on young peoples modern apprenticeships.
- There are issues with the level of information available and access to it.
- Currently introducing ‘Wheels to Work’ in South Devon.
- Working closely with Teignbridge youth council to ensure that young people will have a sense of ownership in the project and that it will address their needs.
- It is important to get support to fill the gaps in the transport network.

Recommendations

- Require support to fill gaps in community transport provision.
- Increased / improved communications - helping individuals to understand travel information and options (personalised travel planning).
- Young people would benefit from the extension of ‘Life in the bus lane’.
- Key Messages: Innovative transport schemes need more support in terms of developing them and funding them.
- Continued Devon County Council support for shop mobility, ring and ride services (both of which are not available county wide) and new and existing wheels to work projects are all important in LTP2.
