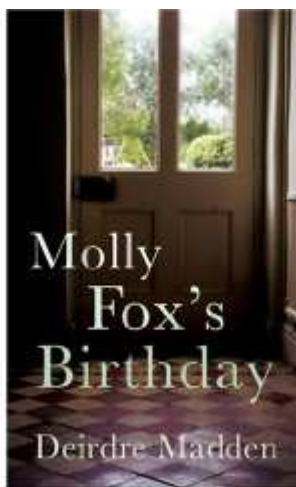


## **Molly Fox's Birthday by Deirdre Madden**
