**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT AND OF
PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS FOR THE ALTERATION OF A STRUCTURE PLAN
DEVON STRUCTURE PLAN 2001 TO 2016**

The Examination in Public into these proposals has been held and the report of the person holding the examination in public has been considered by the Devon Structure Plan Authorities.

The Joint Committee responsible for the preparation of the Devon Structure Plan 2001 to 2016, representing Devon County Council, Plymouth City Council, Torbay Council and Dartmoor National Park Authority, propose to modify the these proposals.

Objections to and representations in respect of the proposed modifications and the intention not to modify the proposals in accordance with certain recommendations in the report should be sent in writing (1) to:

Objections and representations should specify the matters to which they relate and the grounds on which they are made. They may be accompanied by a request to be notified at a specific address of the withdrawal, adoption, approval or rejection of the proposals.

If no objections are received during the period given for making objections the Joint Committee will recommend the Structure Plan Authorities to adopt the policies and proposals.
