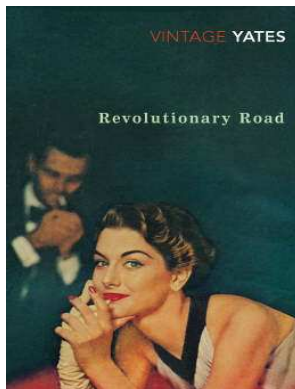


Revolutionary Road by Richard Yates
