### DEFINITIVE MAP REVIEW OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY PARISH OF TAWSTOCK

The Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 requires the County Council to keep the Definitive Map of public rights of way under continuous review and to make modifications where it appears that routes should be added, regraded or deleted. A review is currently being undertaken in the Parish of Tawstock.

A suggestion has been made to modify the Definitive Map for Tawstock for the route shown on the adjoining plan:

#### **Route 1: unrecorded route to bridleway A – B**

From the county road near Tawstock Court and St Peter's Church, point A, in a south southeasterly direction along a track through woods, known as 'Golden Valley', for about 1415 metres to end at the county road, near Woodparks Lodge, point B.
