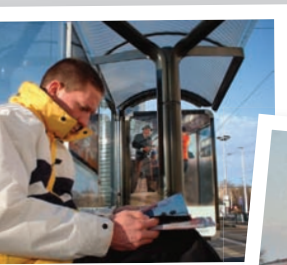

for transport **now!**

Why do I need to apply so early?

We transport around 22,000 students twice a day. We need you to apply early so we can sort everything out in time.



If I apply late will you refund my fares?

No. If you want transport from the beginning of term you must apply by **1 June 2009** – or you may have to pay your own fare for the first few weeks.

How much is it?

The cost for **2009/2010 is £288** which you can pay in monthly instalments. If you pay the full amount in advance we will give you a £30 discount. You may be able to get transport for free if you or your parents get one of the means-tested benefits. There are more details on the application form.



When do I need to pay?

You must send your payment or evidence of getting benefits by **10 August 2009** to get a permit before the beginning of term.

I'm staying at the same school or college do I have to apply?

Yes. Every student has to apply every year.

Can I get transport to any college?

No. There are rules about which college you can get transport to, so you need to check. There are details on the application form. If we turn down your request for transport your college may be able to help you.

What if I change my mind about going to college?

No problem. Just tell us and we will cancel your transport and arrange a refund.

How will I know where to get the bus?

We will send you a letter telling you where and when to get your bus when we send your permit.



Where can I get an application form?

We send forms to year 11 and returning post 16 students in March and April. If you haven't had a form by the end of April call **0845 155 1019** to get one.
