Exclusive film clips to improve bikers' performance go live on YouTube.



Crank those riding skills to the max as RoSPA qualified motorcycling expert, Glen Julian, on the *brand new* Suzuki GSX-R1000 K9 bike, helps you read the road to perfection.

A series of four films, championed by Devon County Council, aim to educate and enhance bikers' current skills with the added benefit of improving safety on the road. The film clinics are being launched in succession and have been created to help bikers improve their performance, by altering existing habits, giving tips and hints on how to improve their 'ride.' Each film is shot in high definition (HD) from seven camera angle views so audiences can follow the exhilarating journey, enhanced with live technical commentary and analysis.

The first dynamic chapter is released on the 11th May and focuses upon gearing up to carve corners. Shot in Devon, the location delivers many opportunities for right and left hand bend negotiation with junction and bridge obstacles. The clinic will outline positioning, gears, braking, speed and anticipating bends.

The next 'clinic,' focused upon urban riding, will be released on 1st June and will demonstrate how to handle obstacles pulling out in front of the bike. 'Overtaking' and 'Junctions' will follow on 22nd June and 13th July.

The films are part of a wider project, the Country Mile, each clinic reflects methods employed during on-the-ground, one-to-one training exclusive to Devon Drivers' Centre. The training available contributes to motorcyclists achieving the Enhanced Rider Scheme (ERS) certificate.
