

## **FREE ACCESS TO THE 1911 CENSUS AND FIND MY PAST AT DEVON RECORD OFFICE**

Thanks to arrangements made by the National Archives with Find My Past, the 1911 census is again available for free on selected public access computers in the refreshment room and the searchroom. This time, we are offering the 1911 census through the Find My Past website, along with access to all of the sources on Find My Past as well. We will be offering free access to these sites until the third week of October 2010.

In order to offer this service fairly to all visitors, we will be keeping the current access arrangements for use of our public access computers.

We will be offering hour-long sessions on all of our computers from 10 a.m. until 6 p.m. Access to computer sessions will be allocated by staff through the Devon Record Office reception desk. We will not be taking advance bookings by telephone or email, but visitors to the record office will be able to book a session on the day.

Those visitors wishing to access other websites such as Ancestry, or to use the computers for other purposes, will also be required to book a session, in the same way as they have been doing since September 2009.
