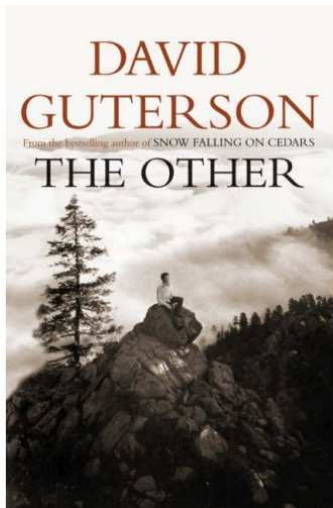


## The Other by David Guterson



Seattle born Guterson began to publish stories and essays in small magazines and periodicals including articles on environmental issues, travel writing and human interest features while working as a teacher. His first book, a collection of short stories, was published in 1989 and a second in 1992 containing essays on family and education.

In 1994 he published 'Snow Falling on Cedars', the book for which he is best known and which went on to win the 1995 PEN/Faulkner Award. It was adapted for a film and received an Academy Award nomination for cinematography.
