Grants can be used in a variety of ways, including:-

- Visiting waste and recycling facilities (including transport costs).
- Purchasing equipment to assist with practical recycling in schools e.g. recycling boxes.
- Developing an educational area about recycling or composting.
- Purchasing equipment to assist in waste education e.g. paper making kit, books, waste and recycling games.
