## What can I borrow?

You can borrow up to\* -

- 12 books for 4 weeks
- 4 DVDs for 2 weeks
- 4 audio books for 4 weeks

Borrow from your mobile library and take back to your local library.

\* varies for under 16s and people who are disabled.

## How much does it cost?

Joining is **FREE**. Join at any age – babies too. Join at your mobile library, no ID needed.

Borrowing books is **FREE**.

Non-fiction and children's books can be reserved **FREE**.

There is a small charge for renting DVDs, audio books and for reserving fiction books.

## When does the mobile library visit?
