				<p>2.3.13 PPS 10 requires that Regional Spatial Strategies should propose a distribution of waste tonnage requiring management and identify a pattern of waste management facilities, with a Regional Technical Advisory Body convened to advise on the preparation of the regional strategy. The South West RTAB was formally established in January 2000. At a local level, PPS 10 requires that waste planning authorities should implement the requirements of the RSS by identifying sites and areas for waste management facilities, by considering opportunities for management of waste at the point where it arises together with a broad range of locations such as industrial sites and other previously-developed land.</p> <p>2.3.14 With regard to human health, PPS 10 confirms that modern, well-run and regulated facilities should pose little risk. However, it is confirmed that the planning system should ensure that the location of waste development is acceptable and that health can be a material consideration in such decisions.
