| Summary of Alternatives or Options considered and rejected | The Council considered whether it should honour the payment of an additional 1.5% in relation to banded fees, bearing in mind the extra cost of meeting the new NLW. It concluded that it had entered into that commitment in good faith and that it should be paid in the coming year as part of the Council's continued commitment to securing a sufficient and sustainable market. An impact assessment has been undertaken and careful attention has been given to ensuring that the needs of people with protected characteristics are addressed. | | | |
