Decision Taken	Following engagement and formal consultation with the care homes market, the following decision was taken: To implement a new fee model, allocating fees according to hours of care needed instead of banded rates, from 4 th June 2018.

Summary of Alternatives or Options considered and rejected	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To continue with the banded rates. This was rejected following extensive market engagement undertaken as part of the review of the fee model. 2. To make an award greater than the offer. Rejected as the offer is fair and reasonable and provides for inflationary pressures included in the model. 3. To award no increase in fees from the 2017/18 levels. This was rejected as being unreasonable in light of increased costs being experienced by providers through increases in National Living Wage and National Minimum Wage and inflation
