Summary of Matter or Issue Requiring Decision

The award of inflationary uplift for care home fees for 2019/20

Decision Taken

Following engagement and formal consultation with the care homes market, the following decisions were taken:

- 1) To award an aggregate increase of 3.78% on banded fees
- 2) To increase non-banded fees, which are negotiated individually, at the same rate of 3.78% as calculated by our approach to banded fees
- 3) To award increases to the personalised fee model rates as follows:
- a. 2.61% increase to residential accommodation
- b. 2.77% increase to nursing accommodation c. 5.65% increase to the care hour element

Summary of Reason(s) for Decision Taken

Summary of Alternatives or Options considered and rejected

- 1) To make an award greater than the offer. This option was rejected as the offer is fair and reasonable and provides for inflationary pressures.
- 2) To award no increase in fees from the 2018/19 levels. This was rejected as being unreasonable considering increased costs being experienced by providers
