Decision to purchase additional spot purchases for the following:
Issue Based Advocacy for Children and Young People
Children and Young People's Advocacy
Independent Visiting Service.

Decision Taken

- To spot purchase up to 2,593 hours per year (indicative 617 referrals) for Issue Based Advocacy for Children
 - A purchase of an additional volume of 6 'matches' for Independent Visitor services
- The spot purchases are to be made under the existing contract with National Youth Advocacy Service (NYAS), The Factory, 14 Alder Hills, Poole, BH12 4AS
