### Summary of Matter or Issue Requiring Decision

Decision to extend the validity periods, alter the regulation definitions, and revise the team structure and adjust the permit fee levels, for the Permit For Works scheme, following a review of the operational data. Although included in the Proposal the Permit Fee levels are **not** included in this decision.

### Decision Taken

Decision to make the above amendments to the Permit for Works Scheme, following a review of 12 months of operational data. The potential recruitment exercise will start in January 2022, the 4 week statutory consultation period will start in February 2022, and we will review consultation responses in March 2022, with a go live for changes in April 2022 (FY change).
