Our team supports families and individuals who are resettling in Devon, having left their home country because their lives are at risk. We can offer time limited assistance including:

- Understanding cultural differences.
- Health & emotional wellbeing support.
- Finding community resources & groups.
- Helping with household challenges, for example: finances and benefits.
- Exploring employment choices: getting into work, volunteering opportunities and adult education.
- Supporting with your children's education.
- Assisting with language & communication needs.
- Supporting young people and their needs.
- Supporting with family life & parenting.
- Supporting people without recourse to public funds.
- Signposting to other services for example: immigration and housing.
- Connecting you with other families and individuals for support.
